Task 1 – Have a go re-writing the poem using different similes to describe the colours in Welsh.

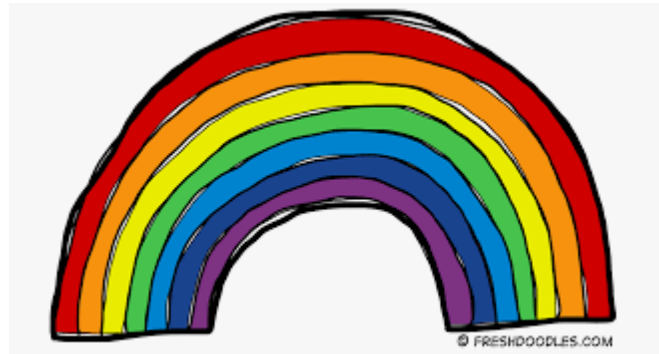

The Weather - The following tasks are in the ‘The Weather’ in j2e ‘shared files’ on Hwb.

Task 1 - Read ‘What is weather?’ and answer the questions.

Task 2 - Read and discuss ‘Weather scientists’.

Task 3 - Collect and record measurements for the weather over one week using the ‘Recording the weather’ worksheet.

First of all, collect your own weather measuring instruments together. You could make a simple rain gauge to measure the amount of rainfall from an empty plastic bottle; a weather vane to find the direction of the wind; an anemometer to measure the wind speed. You will also need a thermometer to measure the temperature outside. Look online for easy ideas but don’t worry if you can’t get them all.

Task 4 - Read and complete the worksheet ‘Testing a weather forecast’.
